Information about our field trip from the park:

"For the younger students we will be spending time at some of our favorite spots at Mississippi Gateway Park, learning from a piece of nature, observing with one of their senses, and practicing the most important trait of a naturalist: learning from nature. For the older students, they will be getting into rubber boots (which we provide) and enter the river using kick nets to collect organisms from the water, and studying them. Based on the life present in the river, students will use the biotic index chart to determine if the water is healthy or not.

Reminder for students: We will be outdoors for this entire field trip. Please ask them to dress for the weather. There is a chance that your younger students might get a little dirty and the older students may get wet, as we will be walking in the river. Encourage students to wear clothes that it wouldn't upset them to get a little dirty, and for the older students to have an extra set of clothes at school that they could change into if they accidentally get very wet.

Chaperones: Chaperones are very welcome. Please communicate to potential chaperones that they will be outdoors for this field trip; and they may be walking on uneven ground (any chaperones with the older students will definitely be walking on uneven ground."
